Information for Authors

Preamble

The Editorial Committee of the African Journal of Environmental Research (AJER) invites submission of articles for December 2018 (double issue) edition of her publication in line with her published objectives. The goal is to simultaneously publish two issues. This will be as follows:

Issue 1 will be a **multi-themed edition**. Authors may choose to write on their areas of special interest in the Environmental Sciences.

Issue 2 will be focused on the theme 'PUBLIC HOUSING AND PHYSICAL PLANNING EFFORTS IN NIGERIA FROM 1914 TO 2016: AN EVALUATION'. Nigeria was created under the British rule by the amalgamation of the British Northern and Southern protectorates in 1914. This signaled the beginning of formalization/harmonization of laws to develop the area. The Committee believes that after over a century of existence and development in the country, there is the need for examination, from different perspectives, of progress made and document possible lessons that, if taken, can aid future policymaking.
